So now you must be equipped! Equipped to SEE, Equipped to SERVE, and Equipped to be SENT!


- 1. You must begin to SEE the vision that God has purposed for Kingdom Come Ministries as God begins to reveal to you His purpose and design for your life!

Why the Church?

Let's review why Christ established His church so we can be effective and focused in service.

Matthew 28:18-20

¹⁸ Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

1 Peter 2:9-10

⁹ But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. ¹⁰ Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

Who? Understood responsibility of "Us"

What are we doing? Bring together a group of remarkable people

Where are we doing this? The implied "where" can be identified as "here" or, more specifically, on the battlefield

Why are we doing this?

- 1. To See if we could become something more!
- 2. To Fight the battles that they never could

When are we doing this? When the time comes (For such a time as this)

Once a "WHY" is established, any group or individual is provided clarity relative to its existence and purpose of operation!

What is the "WHY" for Kingdom Come Ministries?

Organizations often identify their "WHY" in their Mission & Vision Statements! Next, let's examine the Mission and Vision Statements of Kingdom Come Ministries!

KCM Statement of Purpose: (WHY ARE WE HERE?)

 The purpose of the Kingdom Come Ministries shall be the salvation of sinners, sanctification of believers, growth and perfection of the saints, preaching of the gospel of Jesus Christ, and redemptive service to the community and its people.

KCM Mission Statement: (WHAT ARE WE DOING?)

 Our unified mission is to impact the world with the gospel of Jesus Christ and equip the family for ministry in which God has enabled us as stated in (*Hebrews 13:20, 21*). We will achieve success with intense work, uninhibited worship, and participation from people of all races, creeds, and nationalities

KCM Vision Statement: (HOW WILL WE DO IT?)

 As we proclaim Jesus, the Christ, as head of the church and the manifested Word of God, our goal is to teach the Word of God with simplicity and understanding so that it may be applied to our everyday lives in a practical and effective manner, thereby being transformed into a people who changes the world; changing our immediate world and all those with whom we come into contact, ultimately making a mark that cannot be erased. (*Proverbs 29:18*)

How to Create Vision
